Actors Ink student to International STAR[☆]

Many people are looking for the secret of success and often ask me what they have to do to make it. My answer is simple "Be ready when your time comes" There are many roads to FAME. I have been part of many of these roads for many actors and performers but none as well known as Teresa Palmer.



Nobody becomes famous on their own there are always important people along the way to help you there so here are a few tips.

1. Know your craft, be ready for when your time comes, keep your skills sharp.
2. Provide your agent with all the tools required to represent you - Photo, CV, Show reel, demo
3. Create networks and learn as much as you can about the business / people who can help you on your journey
4. Respect your agent. You need 100% support of your agent as this is the person who creates the first opportunity for you in the ladder to success.

In Teresa's case she had just missed out on Mighty Morphin Power Rangers for a second time... It had come down to her and another girl in the National casting and the other girl won the role as she had some experience in martial arts. A brief had come through for a feature film shooting in Adelaide starring Daniel Radcliffe (Harry Potter) looking for a 14 year old girl to play a support role opposite him. The auditions in Adelaide were coming to a close after auditioning despite every girl in Adelaide aged 14 yet still the producers hadn't found the girl they were after. At the time Teresa was 16 and too old for the brief and it was a passing comment to casting agent Ann Fay "bad luck the producers weren't looking for a girl a bit older because I have a girl;" Teresa Palmer who would be perfect. Ann Fay said to throw her into the end of her Adelaide casting and they were blown away by her.

Shortly after winning the role in December Boys Teresa was cast in Murali Thulleri's 2.37 which also went Global, at this point Teresa went to live in Sydney as casting agents and producers began requesting Teresa audition for roles in their films.

The media attention her first two films got along with her great performances launched Teresa's career.

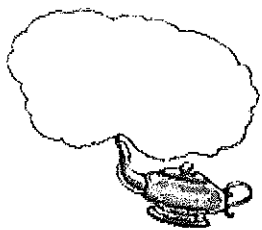
